

Suggested Criteria for Participant Letter Recognition

1. Active participation on the team following the Creighton Prep High School Trapshooting.
2. Team Code of Conduct. (Code of Conduct applies to all team events – Practices, ECTC.
3. Conference Shoots, Cornhusker Cup, etc.
4. Active participation at practice, including assistance with trap loading, scoring, pulling, etc. (or have EXCUSED absence from these events)
5. Active participation in Creighton Prep Alumni Fall Warm Up Shoot.
6. Minimum of three (3) years Senior Division involvement with minimum of four ECTC shoots per year AND Nebraska Cornhusker Cup shoot.
OR
7. win a medal at an ECTC Conference Trapshooting Conference shoot
OR
8. Top 10% of the ECTC Conference Average
OR
9. Medaling at an event at the Nebraska Cornhusker Shoot at Doniphan
OR
10. Top 10% of the Nebraska Cornhusker Cup average scores at the State Champion shoot at Doniphan
OR
11. at the coaches discretion

Coach reserves the right to make final decisions on lettering awards.

Creighton Prep Trapshooting Team Code of Conducts for Team Activities

Code of Conduct for Team Activities: All students participating in team activities are representing not only themselves, but also their school and community in all their actions. With this in mind, we hope that all of our students' actions reflect a positive position toward each other, our opponents, and the training obligations that are an accepted part of team activities. There shall be an immediate suspension from team activities if it is determined by the head coach, sponsor, or activities coordinator that a student has broken the laws of the State of Nebraska (except minor traffic violations); maliciously destroyed property; had possession of or used tobacco, alcohol, or drugs; or has been guilty of other "conduct unbecoming a student involved in team activities".

All violations that constitute "conduct unbecoming a student involved in team activities" should be reported by any team official, by any student or by any parent to the team coordinator, director, and sponsor or head coach. Any team official may report violations by reason of "conduct unbecoming a student involved in team activities" when the severity of the violation is deemed to merit reporting. Actions taken toward a team member shall be at the sole discretion of the Head Coach.
